San Tan ADMS Update

This update encompasses the southern areas of the Town of Queen Creek and City of Gilbert. Following the July; 2017 summer monsoons in the San Tan Mountains, several areas experienced flooding. Part of this Study will analyze replacement for the 'Farmers Dike' located on GRIC property, south of Gilbert. In addition, the Goldmine Equestrian Estates subdivision in Queen Creek but within Pinal County has experienced recent flooding. District staff is also working closely with County Planning & Development staff to identify sources of flooding for the unincorporated area north of Hunt Highway and south of Riggs Road. The study will identify flooding solutions starting in fall of 2018.

Queen Creek ADMS Update

The study for this 16 square mile area is scheduled to start by early fall, 2019. The Study goals are to update the hydrology through utilization of FLO-2D modeling. Following completion of the modeling, flood hazard locations will be identified and alternatives developed working closely with the Town of Queen Creek and impacted residents.
